ABCs of SALVATION

ADAM + OLIVIA

FAMILY OPENING

Let's talk about the ABCs of Salvation — the simple way the Bible explains how we begin a relationship with Jesus.

A - ADMIT B - BELIEVE C - CONFESS

Everyone in this family is at a different place with God, and that's okay. Tonight is about learning together.

A - ADMIT

We all mess up and need a Savior

READ ROMANS 3:23

For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.

FAMILY DISCUSSION

Pick two or three...

For Littles:

- What does it mean to make a wrong choice?
- Can even grown-ups mess up?

For Older Kids & Teens:

- Why do people compare themselves to others instead of admitting sin?
- Why is it hard to admit we need help?

For Everyone:

- Why do you think admitting sin is the first step toward God?

FAMILY TRUTH

We don't need to pretend with God. He already knows



B - BELIEVE

Salvation is a gift we receive by faith

READ ROMANS 10:9

If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

FAMILY DISCUSSION

For Littles:

- What is something you trust?
- Do you think Jesus loves you?

For Older Kids & Teens:

- What's the difference between knowing about Jesus and trusting Him?
- Why do people try to earn God's love?

For Parents:

- Share a moment when trusting God was hard for you.

FAMILY ILLUSTRATION

Ask: What's the best gift you've ever received?

Salvation is a gift we don't earn — we receive it because God loves us.

FAMILY TRUTH

Faith is trusting Jesus with our lives



C - CONFESS

We choose Jesus and follow Him

READ ROMANS 10:10

For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.

FAMILY DISCUSSION

For Littles:

- Who do we follow?
- How can we show we love Jesus?

For Older Kids & Teens:

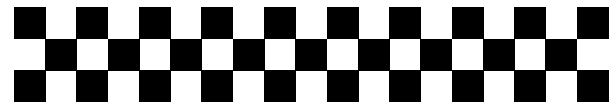
- Why can it feel scary to talk about faith?
- What does following Jesus look like at school or work?

For Everyone:

- What does it mean to live like Jesus is Lord?

FAMILY RESPONSE MOMENT

Have everyone say together: Jesus is Lord, and we choose to follow Him!



FINAL TAKE AWAY

- A — I admit I need Jesus
- B — I believe Jesus saves
- C — I confess Jesus is Lord

CLOSING PRAYER

Jesus, thank You for loving our family. We admit that we mess up. We believe You are the Son of God. We confess that You are Lord. Help us follow You every day. Amen.

CHALLENGE

At dinner or bedtime, ask: Which letter did we live out today — A, B, or C?

This study is not about pressure — it's about conversation. Let kids ask questions. Let teens wrestle. Let grace lead.
