



CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST | GALATIANS 2:15-21 | PASTOR ADAM AZIZ

DAY 1 | HOW DO I KNOW I'M RIGHT WITH GOD?

Read: Luke 18:9-14

Journal:

- Everything the Pharisee said about himself was true. So what exactly was wrong with his prayer?
- When I answer “am I right with God today,” what do I actually reach for first?
- Which of these two men prayed my prayer this week?

Prayer: “God, I stop building a case for myself. Be merciful to me, a sinner.”

DAY 2 | THE VERDICT I DIDN'T EARN

Read: Romans 3:21-26

Reflect:

- “Made right with God” is a courtroom word. Who is the Judge, and what did He declare over me?
- Vs 26 says God is both just and the One who makes sinners right. How did He manage to be both?
- Do I live like the verdict is settled, or like the trial is still going?

Prayer: “Father, thank You that my case is closed. I stop re-opening what You already ruled on.”

DAY 3 | BELIEVING INTO HIM

Read: John 3:14–18

Assignment:

- Write out John 3:16 and put your own name in place of “whoever” and “the world.”
- Read it out loud three times.

Journal honestly:

- Where has my faith been agreement about Jesus instead of running to Jesus?
- The chair is right there. What is keeping me from sitting down in it?

Prayer: “Jesus, I am done building my own chair. I sit down in what You finished.”

DAY 4 | WHAT THE MIRROR SHOWS

Read: Romans 7:7–12

Reflect:

- Paul says the law is holy and good. So what is the law actually FOR?
- What has God’s Word exposed in me lately that I have been trying to fix by trying harder?
- Am I using Scripture as a mirror to see, or as a ladder to climb?

Prayer: “Lord, thank You for showing me the truth about myself. Now wash what the mirror exposed.”

DAY 5 | CONSIDER YOURSELF DEAD

Read: Romans 6:1–11

Journal:

- Verse 11 says to “consider” yourself dead to sin. What does that actually look like on a Tuesday?
- What sin still talks to me like it owns me?
- It may still fight me — but it does not have to master me. What changes if I believe that today?

Prayer: “God, I reckon it done. That person is dead. Christ lives in me now.”

DAY 6 | GARBAGE IN THE LOSS COLUMN

Read: Philippians 3:4–11

Assignment:

- Make two columns on a page. On the left, list everything you quietly count on to feel acceptable.
- Draw a line through the whole column. Write “Gain Christ” on the right.

Reflect deeply:

- Which item on that list was the hardest to cross out? Why?
- What would my walk look like if Christ alone were my confidence this week?

Prayer: “Jesus, I move it all to the loss column. You are my only gain.”

DAY 7 | NO NEED FOR CHRIST TO DIE

Read: Hebrews 10:11–18

Journal:

- Verse 12 says He sat down. What does a seated Priest tell me about the work being finished?
- What am I still trying to pay for that Jesus already purchased?
- What does obedience look like in the next seven days — specifically?

Declaration: “I have been crucified with Christ. I no longer live — Christ lives in me.”

Prayer: “God, I stop writing checks on a debt You already stamped paid. It is finished.”
