QUESTION 1 | Two Men Praying *(Take 7 minutes)*

Read: Luke 18:9–14

- Jesus tells the story of justification. Everything the Pharisee said was true — so what was wrong with it?
- The tax collector went home “justified.” What does that word mean after tonight?
- Which man’s prayer sounds more like yours this week?

QUESTION 2 | Consider Yourself Dead *(Take 7 minutes)*

Read: Romans 6:1–11

- Paul answers the same accusation here. How does he argue it differently than in Galatians?
- Verse 11 says to “consider” yourself dead to sin. What does it look like to actually do that?
- Where do you need to preach your own funeral this week?

QUESTION 3 | What’s Still on Your Résumé? *(Take 7 minutes)*

Read: Philippians 3:4–9

- List everything Paul had. Why did he move all of it to the loss column?
- What is still on your list that you are secretly counting on?
- What would it cost you to call that thing garbage?

QUESTION 4 | Not By Works *(Take 7 minutes)*

Read: Ephesians 2:1–10

- Verses 8–9 say not by works. Verse 10 says created for good works. How do those fit together?
- Why does God make sure that no one can boast?
- Are you working “for” acceptance or “from” it? How can you tell the difference?
