



NO OTHER GOSPEL | GALATIANS 1:1-2:14 | PASTOR ADAM AZIZ

DAY 1 | THE RELIGION IN MY MIRROR

Read: Psalm 139:23–24

Journal:

- Where have I been reading Galatians looking for somebody else's legalism?
- What is the "and also" I have quietly added to Jesus?
- What has it already cost me — in joy, in rest, in freedom?

Prayer: "God, search me. Show me the religion in my own mirror, not just in everybody else's."

DAY 2 | TWO DIFFERENT YOKES

Read: Matthew 11:28–30

Reflect:

- Jesus offers a yoke, and so did the Judaizers. What makes His different?
- What am I carrying right now that He never handed me?
- What would it look like to actually rest this week instead of perform?

Prayer: "Jesus, I trade my yoke for Yours. Teach me what rest actually looks like."

DAY 3 | JESUS PLUS

Read: Colossians 2:16–23

Journal honestly:

- What “add-ons” does Paul name here — and what does he say they actually accomplish?
- Verse 23 says these rules have “an appearance of wisdom.” Which ones have looked like wisdom to me?
- Any addition to the gospel is a subtraction from Christ. Where have I made the Savior smaller?

Prayer: “Lord, I stop adding to what You finished. Christ is enough. Christ is all.”

DAY 4 | GRACE, PEACE, AND NO SCORECARD

Read: Galatians 1:3–4, Ephesians 2:8–9

Assignment:

- Write out Ephesians 2:8–9 in your own words.
- Then write your name in place of “you.” Read it out loud.

Reflect:

- Legalism comes for my rest. Where has my peace gone missing?
- Do I wake up asking whether God is pleased with me based on how yesterday went?
- What would change today if I believed my standing with God was already settled?

Prayer: “Father, thank You that I am not on trial. I receive grace and I receive peace.”

DAY 5 | THE HIDDEN SEASON

Read: Isaiah 49:1–3

Reflect deeply:

- What did God do to the prophet — and when — before He ever used him publicly?
- What is God sharpening in me that nobody can see?
- What am I tempted to do to get out of this season early?
- Is my calling resting on God’s word about me, or on somebody’s approval of me?

Prayer: “God, I stop despising the hidden place. Finish what You started in me before You use me.”

DAY 6 | THE FEAR OF MAN

Read: John 12:42–43, Proverbs 29:25

Journal honestly:

- What did these leaders believe — and what kept them from saying it out loud?
- Peter knew better and still folded at a dinner table. Where do I flinch?
- Whose approval can still change what I say? Write the name down.
- What has my silence already cost somebody else?

Prayer: “Lord, I break the agreement I made with the fear of man. Your approval is enough.”

DAY 7 | CHOOSING FREEDOM

Read: Galatians 5:1, 2 Corinthians 3:17

Journal:

- What is the one thing God asked me to put down this week?
- Where am I still working a checklist He never gave me?
- What does obedience look like in the next seven days — specifically?

Declaration: “Christ has set me free. I will stand free. I will not pick up that yoke again.”

Prayer: “God, I receive what Jesus finished. I will not pay again for what He already purchased.”
